

WHAT CREDIT IS AVAILABLE?

- Earn professional development *upper division continuing education units* at CABE 2020.
- University transcripts will be available upon successful completion and verification of all course requirements.
- **IMPORTANT:** Prior to enrolling, participants should check district requirements regarding CEU acceptance and salary point equivalency.

HOW DO I ENROLL?

Participants must register for university credit **prior to attending any workshop or institute** that will be utilized to earn university credit.

Submit a summary paper that (a) synthesizes your articles/readings (b) synthesizes what you've learned and (c) identifies implications of conference content and selected readings for classroom use: <u>6 pages</u> – typed, double-spaced with at least 3 references = <u>15 hours independent work</u>.
