

CFA Backs Anti-Racism and Social Justice Bills and Resolutions

Big Victory- Before the pandemic hit, CFA's actions prompted CALPERS, the biggest pension fund in the USA to divest from migrant detention centers.

Also, CFA has strongly supported Black Lives Matter and Stop Asian Violence Movements.
