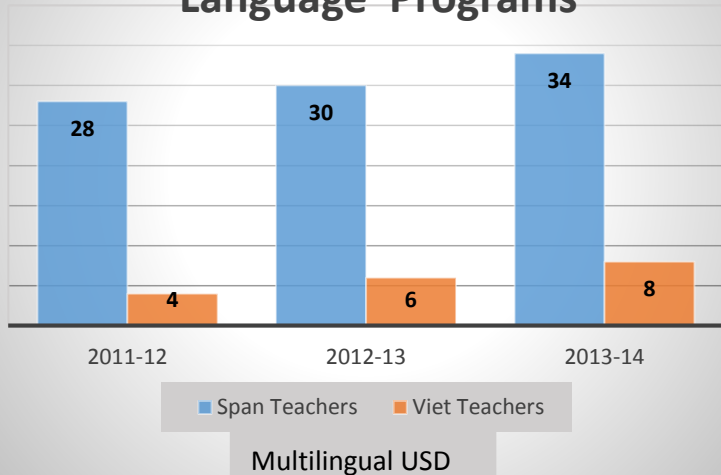

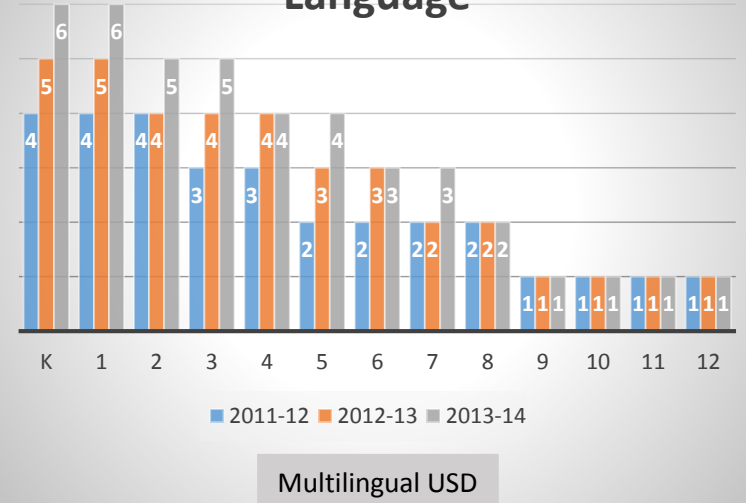

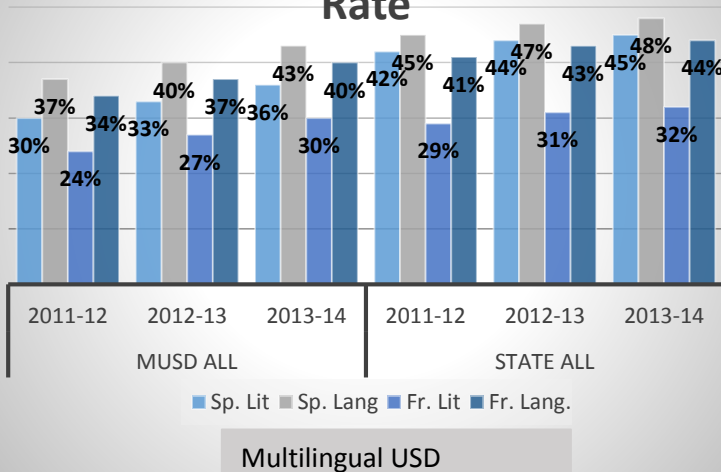
The rate of students passing the AP test in CA has remained constant, while the rate in CUSD has dipped 2 points in the last three years.

Statewide, the percentage of students scoring 1500+ on the SAT has decreased 1 point each of the last two years. CUSD students are scoring approximately 40 points lower year to year, as compared to all students in the state.

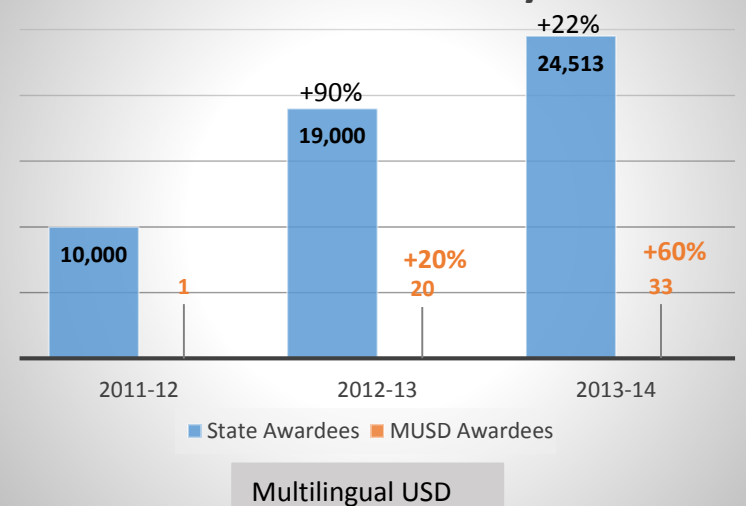

ELs AP World Language Pass Rate

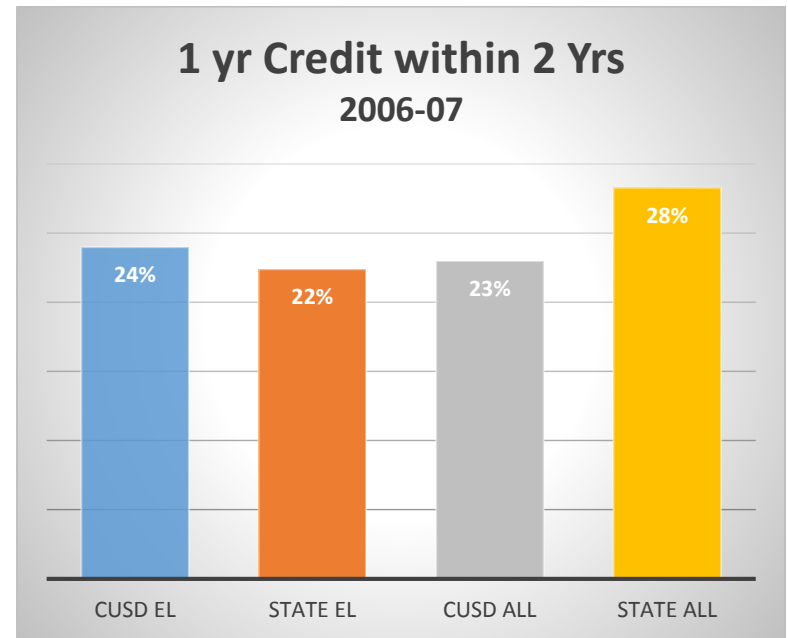
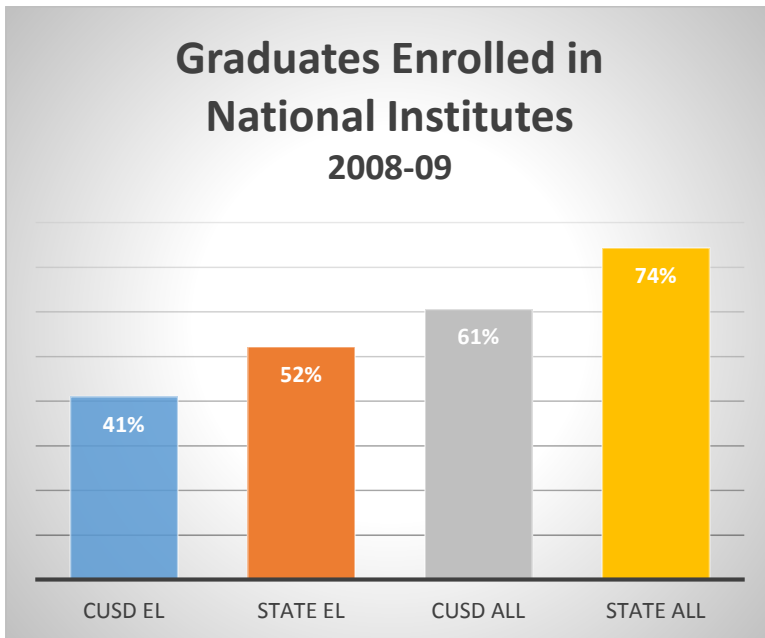
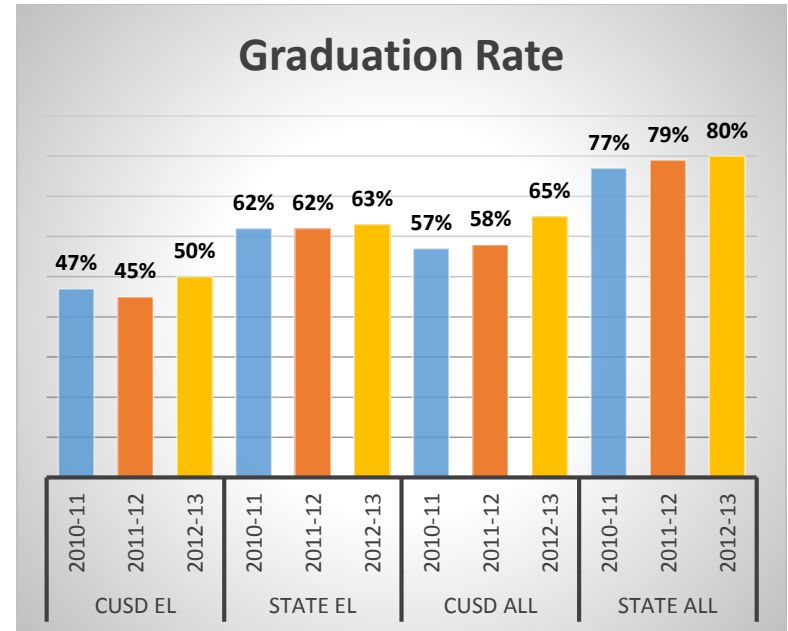

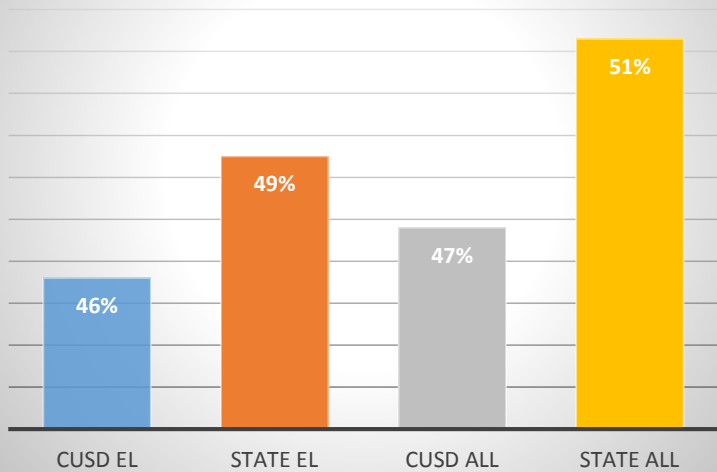


The percentage of CUSD students scoring 21+ on the ACT has increased since 2011, while the state score has remained relatively constant. However, the gap is wider than it is for the SAT.

Graduation rates have increased everywhere, but CUSD ELs still lag behind STATE ELs, though the gap is narrower than it is between CUSD and state students.

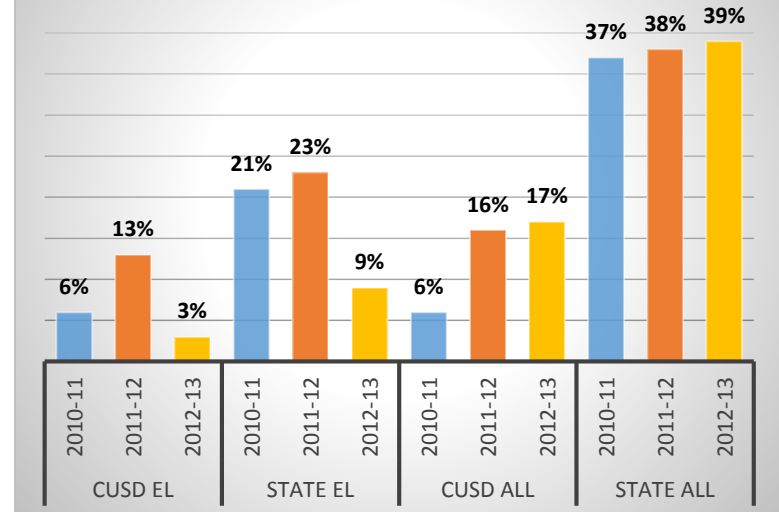


Graduates in CA IHEs 2006-07

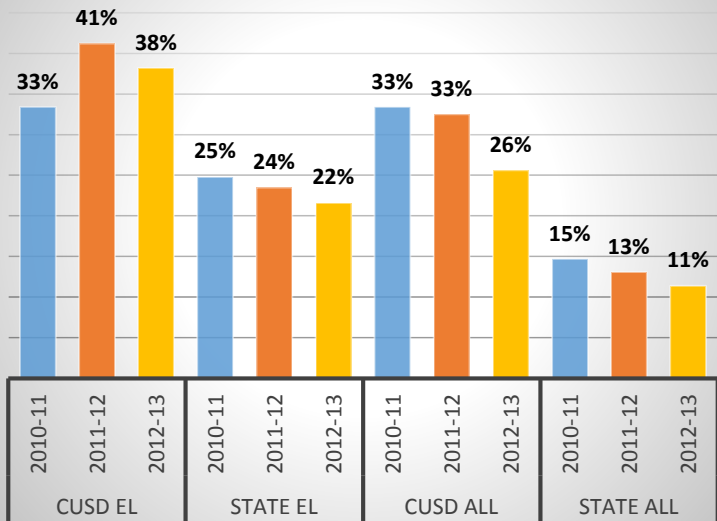


While rates of completion of A-G requirements has increased for all CA and CUSD students, it decreased for CUSD and CA ELs in 2013.

While STATE EL, CUSD, and STATE ALL dropout rates have decreased for the last three years, CUSD ELs saw their rate of dropping out increase in 2012 before decreasing in 2013. Still, over the last three years there has been a 5 point increase.
